Incidents of a public interest from the last week:-

ALCESTER

- *Theft / Rogue Trader. Seymour Road. Alcester. Two men went to the house of a vulnerable elderly resident was driven to a cashpoint in Alcester so they could withdraw money for the work. The work was completed. The men were in a van with a registration number starting 'YN13'. Enquires ongoing.
