### **Nature jottings from Perrymill Lane**

Last month I mentioned that we had not yet seen the first winter thrush visitors. Just a few days after writing that we had our first sightings.

14<sup>th</sup> Nov. From the field footpath to Coughton we noticed a flock of Fieldfares moving from tree to tree. Mixed in with the flock were a few Redwings, with a male Yellowhammer looking rather out of place. Autumn colours seemed to be at their most vibrant on this day as evidenced by the vermilion glow of an acer in Martin and Sue's Perrymill Lane garden.

22<sup>nd</sup> Nov. A Fieldfare visited our garden on this very cold but sunny day. It posed on the top of the back hedge, perfectly lit up by the low sun to highlight just how spectacular these birds are.

24<sup>th</sup> Nov. On an afternoon walk along the bridlepath through the woodland we came across a mixed flock of birds feeding in the birch trees. Looking through binoculars we found that the majority were Redpolls, with a smaller number of Siskins, the first we have seen of either species this autumn. We also spotted three Treecreepers and at least two Goldcrests amongst the same party. Long-tailed and Blue Tits also put in an appearance.

25<sup>th</sup> Nov. A Dunnock and a Robin found something of interest on our patio. They are common garden birds, but still nice to observe at close quarters.


9<sup>th</sup> Dec. From the field footpath to Coughton we watched a male Kestrel hovering in search of a meal – the technique that earned the species the old country name of "Windhover". On the topic of birds of prey, I am reminded that Jeannie noticed one in her Perrymill Lane garden. From her description I think it was a male Sparrowhawk.

10<sup>th</sup> Dec. We spent several minutes watching a flock of nine Redpolls feeding in a birch tree in the garden of "Booking Office" in Sambourne Lane, Coughton.



It seems very early to be thinking about the end of January, but don't forget the RSPB's Big Garden Birdwatch on the 28<sup>th</sup>-30<sup>th</sup> January 2022.





Inside Coughton there is a hive of activity during the winter months, as our conservation team dust, vacuum and polish to their hearts content.

In addition to being able to give the house an in-depth clean, winter gives us an opportunity to closely examine every item for signs of wear and pest activity, and to update our records. Of course, we're constantly monitoring the collection and we keep the house clean throughout the year, but during the winter we do this on a much greater scale.

We assess each item individually as to whether to polish it or not - we no longer polish whole items routinely because this cleaning can act as a form of wear and tear. Removing dust helps limit this corrosion. It's a simple thing to do but effective, so we dust regularly throughout the year and top up on the protective wax in winter.

Do you fold your duster in a special way to prevent the edges catching on things? Do you get out a hogs hair brush to get all the dust out of the crevices? Do you have special brushes for cleaning certain items? We do... and these are just a few of our ways of working to keep our collection conserved.

Here are a few top tips from our conservation team! Vinegar and paraffin on a woollen cloth is perfect for buffing wooden floors and keeping them in tip top condition, Renaissance Wax should be used to protect metalwork after cleaning and leatherwork and autosol is fantastic for cleaning brass and copper.

Why not plan a visit this winter to our sister properties over at Baddesley Clinton and Packwood; they're open all year except Christmas Eve and Christmas Day. The first months of the New Year are the perfect time to wrap up warm, throw on some wellies and go for an invigorating walk. Blow away the cobwebs along blustery canal paths or take a frosty stroll across the Warwickshire countryside, now is the ideal time to get outside and enjoy the outdoors.

Over at Packwood during January (whilst stocks last), join Percy the Park Keeper and his animal friends for some winter fun on a trail around the welly walk and give nature a helping hand. The trail will take place between Tuesday 4 January – Sunday 30 January, 9am-3.30pm, so come along and explore the beautiful parkland of Packwood. The trail can be purchased upon arrival from Visitor Reception, £2 per trail.


