Road and Highways.

After many, many emails and site visits to Coughton by Highways, Flood Dept, District and County Councillors and our MP. Work has eventually been undertaken on the roads to help alleviate some of the flooding issues. There were cameras put into the drains, to find out there had been a collapse. Consequently the collapse has been repaired and new manholes have also been fitted. They are still finishing the project at present. There were also new drains fitted at the bottom of Sambourne Lane and 2 new drains and an Acro drain fitted at the bottom of the Fordrough. We are still awaiting contact from National Trust with regards to the field flooding homes.



Coughton & Sambournes Chapel Restoration Project

As you are possibly aware a group of villagers have instigated a restoration project for the chapel in Sambourne Lane. We had a meeting with villagers to gauge their thoughts and offers of help. We had a mainly positive response, some great ideas and offers of help. Obviously any work that is undertaken has to be approved by the diocese. Once approval has been received we will then apply for grants etc. to raise money to complete each phase.

Coughton Ford

A new bench has been purchased from community funds and has been fitted on the grass at the ford. Huge thanks to Adrian Dobbins and his helpers from Australia for installing the bench and completing this work for the community. Rubbish has also been an issue at the ford again, this was reported and removed by the Council. We are still awaiting fitting of a new bin to replace the one lost in the floods.
