### **STUDLEY**

**Going out? - Checklist for securing your home when you leave it** - It's vital to leave your home secure. A 'exit routine' can help ensure that you don't forget obvious, important things, like not leaving your van unlocked. It can be dark before you get home. Here's what you should do just before you go out. Try to get into the habit of doing these things when you lock up your home. This will ensure that you don't forget anything. Here's what we recommend:

- close and lock all your doors and windows, even if you're only going out for a few minutes
- double-lock any door
- make sure that any valuables are out of sight
- keep handbags away from the letterbox or cat flap and hide all keys including car keys, as a thief could find an even a small opening
- never leave car documents or ID in obvious places such as kitchens or hallways
- in the evening, shut the curtains and leave lights on
- if you're out all day, then it's advisable to use a timer device to automatically turn lights and heating on
- set your burglar alarm
- make sure the side gate is locked
- lock your shed or garage
- lock your bike inside a secure shed or garage, to a robust fitting bolted to the ground or wall
