Incidents of a public interest from the last week:-

SAMBOURNE

- *Attempt Theft of Dog, Astwood Bank end of Sambourne Lane, Sambourne. Occupants of vehicle have pulled up alongside caller and have stolen a Puppy which was being carried. The offending vehicle then drove off but threw the Puppy out before leaving the area towards Sambourne. The offenders vehicle is described as a Silver Mercedes with a registration number starting 'YF19'. The driver was a white female with blond hair and the passenger who grabbed the dog was a white male, stocky build, 6' with a shaved head. Four occupants in total.
